

How To Make a Pansy

Pansy Supplies

Punches:

- 3 sets of shapes from Floral Petals MCG64503 in white
- 2 sets of shapes from Floral Petals MCG64503 in purple
- 1 shape from Alpine Snowflake MCG64500 for flower base
- 2 leaves from Birch Leaf MCG64502
- 1 round shape from Punchline MCG53700 - 5/16" round

Tools:

- Paper Tool Kit and Case MCG65800
- Craft Molding Mat MCG65900

Additional:

- Cardstock: Purple Pizzazz, White, Candlelight & Palo Verde (Bazzill) • Vivid Ink pads- Violet Mist, Straw (Clearsnap Inc.) • Foam Ink Applicator (Ranger Industries) • Self Adhesive Jewels: Desert Sun (Bazzill) • Fabri Tac Glue (Beacon Adhesives) • Non-stick Craft mat or scrap paper



Technique #1 - Shaping

Place a punched shape on the Craft Molding Mat (MCG65900) and press down with the large 8mm ball stylus. (Paper Tool Kit MCG65800) Move stylus around in small circular motions to soften card stock, making it easier to manipulate. The paper will curl.



Technique #2 - Pinching

Center the Tweezers, (PaperTool Kit MCG65800), over the narrow end of the shape. With thumb and index finger, gradually pinch the paper around the tweezers. This prepares petal for attaching to the flower base.



Technique #3 - Bending

Hold the pinched end of the shape between finger and thumb. Use the Tweezers to grasp the side of the shape and roll it back to form the natural curve of a petal. Repeat on other side to complete petal.



Technique #4 - Cupping

With the shape on the mat, use the 8mm stylus placed at a 90° angle to the paper. Press down and roll the stylus around in the center of the shape until it cups up. Pinching creates the flower base that petals attach to in the assembly of the flower.



Technique #5 - Assembly

Use the largest Floral Petals shapes. Rub the base of the three white petals lightly with Straw Ink, rub the top of all petals with Violet Mist ink to add color details. Follow Techniques #1, 2, & 3 to turn shapes into petals.

Start Pansy assembly with cupped Snowflake base. Start with the 2 same color petals. Dip the narrow end of each petal in glue and adhere to the cupped Snowflake arms. Glue the group of 3 petals over the previous two petals working one at a time.

[Caution: Don't use glue on or over the Craft Molding Mat. It needs to stay clean and dry.]

Use 1 small round shape for the center of the Pansy. Shape using Technique #1. Glue the small petal into the center of the flower. Add a self-adhesive rhinestone.

Punch 2 Birch Leaf shapes. Follow step #1 to prepare the shape. Use the 1mm stylus to add thin veining details to each leaf. Glue a leaf to each side of the flower to complete the Pansy.
