

Punch...Shape...Assemble

Mold Paper to Create 3D Realistic Flowers

How To Make a Rose



Garden Rose Supplies

Punches:

- 12 Pear shapes from Multi Pear MCG64505
- 10 small Pear shapes from Garden Petals MCG64504
- 2-4 leaves from Birch Leaf MCG64502
- 1 Alpine Snowflake MCG64500 for flower base

Tools:

- Paper Tool Kit and Case MCG65800
- Craft Molding Mat MCG65900

Floral Rose Supplies

Punches:

- 6 sets of shapes from Floral Petals MCG64503
- 2-4 leaves from Birch Leaf MCG64502
- 1 Alpine Snowflake MCG64500 for flower base

- Additional: • Cardstock • Fabri Tac Glue (Beacon Adhesives)
• Non-stick Craft mat or scrap paper

Optional Technique:

Rub edge of each petal with ink pad to add contrasting color. Then form petals.

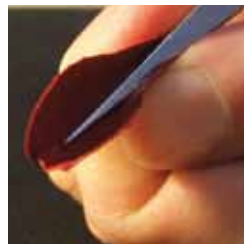
Technique #1 - Shaping

Place a punched shape on the Craft Molding Mat (MCG65900) and press down with the large 8mm ball stylus. (Paper Tool Kit MCG65800) Move stylus around in small circular motions to soften card stock, making it easier to manipulate. The paper will curl.



Technique #2 - Pinching

Center the Tweezers, (PaperTool Kit MCG65800), over the narrow end of the shape. With thumb and index finger, gradually pinch the paper around the tweezers. This prepares petal for attaching to the flower base.



Technique #3 - Bending

Center the Tweezers, (PaperTool Kit MCG65800), over the narrow end of the shape. With thumb and index finger, gradually pinch the paper around the tweezers. This prepares petal for attaching to the flower base.



Technique #4 - Cupping

With the shape on the mat, use the 8mm stylus placed at a 90° angle to the paper. Press down and roll the stylus around in the center of the shape until it cups up. Cupping creates the flower base that petals attach to in the assembly of the flower.



Technique #5 - Assembly

Prepare all petals using Techniques #1, 2 and 3. Start with a cupped Snowflake as the flower base. Dip the narrow end of 6 petals into glue and adhere to the Snowflake arms. Use a clear quick setting paper crafting glue. [Caution: Don't use glue on or over the Craft Molding Mat. It needs to stay clean and dry.] Continue to add petals working around the base offsetting petals until you get to the center. Work from the outside in until desired fullness is achieved. The last 2-3 small petals curl inward to create the center. Punch 2-4 Birch Leaf shapes. Follow Techniques #1 and 2 to prepare the shapes. Use the 1mm stylus to add thin veining details to each leaf. Glue the leaves around the base to complete the Rose.
